RIGHTS INSTRUMENTSStatus of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural
Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and
the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and
Political RightsReport of the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, by its resolution 2200 A (XXI) of 16 December 1966, adopted and opened for signature, ratification or accession the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, and expressed the hope that the Covenants and the Optional Protocol would be signed, ratified or acceded to without delay. The Assembly also requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its future sessions reports concerning the status of ratification of the Covenants and of the Optional Protocol. In response to that request, reports on the status of the International Covenants and the Optional Protocol have been submitted annually to the Assembly since its twenty-second session in 1967.
2. Both Covenants and the Optional Protocol were opened for signature at New York on 19 December 1966. In accordance with their respective provisions, 1/ the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights entered into force on 3 January 1976, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 23 March 1976, and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, having received the required number of ratifications or accessions, entered into force simultaneously with that Covenant on 23 March 1976.
3. In its resolution 46/113 of 17 December 1991, the General Assembly, inter alia, again urged all States that had not yet done so to become parties to both Covenants, as well as to consider acceding to the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; invited the States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights to consider making the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant; appealed to States

parties to the Covenants that had exercised their sovereign right to make reservations in accordance with relevant rules of international law to consider whether any such reservations should be reviewed; and encouraged all Governments to publish the texts of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and to distribute them and make them known as widely as possible in their territories. The Assembly also requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its forty-eighth session a report on the status of the Covenants and the Optional Protocols.

4. As at 1 August 1993, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 123 States, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 122 States and the First Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 73 States. The list of States that have signed, ratified or acceded to the Covenants and the Optional Protocol and the dates of their signatures, ratifications, or accessions appear in annexes I to III of the present report.

5. The General Assembly, by its resolution 44/128 of 15 December 1989, adopted and opened for signature, ratification and accession the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, aimed at the abolition of the death penalty, and called upon all Governments in a position to do so to consider signing and ratifying or acceding to the Second Optional Protocol.

6. The Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 11 July 1991, three months after the date of deposit with the Secretary-General of the tenth instrument of ratification or accession. As at 1 August 1993, the Second Optional Protocol had been ratified or acceded to by 18 States. In addition, it had been signed by another 6 States. The list of States that have signed, ratified or acceded to the Second Optional Protocol, as well as the dates of their signature, ratification or accession thereto, is contained in annex IV to the present report.

7. Upon ratification of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights or subsequently, the Governments of Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belarus, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Congo, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Ecuador, Finland, the Gambia, Germany, Guyana, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Poland, the Republic of Korea, the Russian Federation, Senegal, Slovenia, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, Ukraine, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the United States of America and Zimbabwe made the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee established under article 28 of the Covenant to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article.

8. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, established in accordance with Economic and Social Council resolution 1985/17 of 28 May 1985, held its sixth, seventh and eighth sessions at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 25 November to 13 December 1991, 23 November to 11 December 1992 and 10 to 28 May 1993, respectively. It submitted reports to the Economic and Social Council at its substantive sessions of 1992 and of 1993 2/ in which it made suggestions and recommendations concerning issues arising from the consideration of reports submitted by States parties to the Covenant.

9. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Human Rights Committee held its forty-third session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 21 October to 8 November 1991, its forty-fourth session at United Nations Headquarters from 23 March to 10 April 1992, and its forty-fifth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 13 to 31 July 1992. The forty-sixth session was held at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 19 October to 6 November 1992; the forty-seventh session was held at United Nations Headquarters from 22 March to 8 April 1993; and the forty-eighth session was held at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 12 to 30 July 1993. In accordance with article 45 of the Covenant and article 6 of the First Optional Protocol, the Committee has submitted its annual reports to the General Assembly at its forty-seventh and forty-eighth sessions 3/ which cover the activities of the Committee at its above-mentioned sessions.

b/ Following the adoption by the General Assembly of resolution 2758 (XXVI) of 25 October 1971 on the restoration of the lawful rights of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, by a note addressed to the Secretary-General, received on 29 September 1972, stated:

"1. With regard to the multilateral treaties signed, ratified or acceded to by the defunct Chinese government before the establishment of the People's Republic of China, my Government will examine all their contents before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be recognized.

"2. As from 1 October 1949, the day of the founding of the People's Republic of China, the Chiang Kai-Shek clique has no right at all to represent China. Its signature and ratification of, or accession to, any multilateral treaties by usurping the name of 'China' are all illegal and null and void. My Government will study these multilateral treaties before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be acceded to."

The lists in annexes I to III therefore do not include the signature of the two Covenants and the Optional Protocol on behalf of the "Republic of China" on 5 October 1967.
