LETTER DATED 8 FEBRUARY 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

On behalf of the member states of the Organization of the Islamic Conference Contact Group on Bosnia and Herzegovina comprising Egypt, Islamic Republic of Iran, Malaysia, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Senegal and Turkey, I have the honour to request you to convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the extremely grave situation resulting from the massacre of over 66 civilians by the Serbian gunners in Sarajevo on 5 February 1994.
