Nota de la Secretaría

1. El Consejo Económico y Social, mediante su resolución 1993/4, estableció criterios para la acreditación de las organizaciones no gubernamentales en la Conferencia y su proceso preparatorio, y decidió que la secretaría de la Conferencia se encargara de la recepción y evaluación preliminar de las solicitudes de acreditación provenientes de organizaciones no gubernamentales. Se acreditará para la participación a las organizaciones no gubernamentales reconocidas como entidades consultivas por el Consejo y que manifiesten su deseo de asistir a la Conferencia y a las sesiones de su Comité Preparatorio.

2. El Comité Preparatorio de la Conferencia, en su segundo período de sesiones, celebrado en mayo de 1993, acreditó a 332 organizaciones no gubernamentales (que se enumeran en los documentos E/CONF.84/PC.10/ y Add.1 a 3) para la Conferencia y su proceso preparatorio, de conformidad con la resolución 1993/4 del Consejo. Además, ciertas organizaciones no gubernamentales reconocidas como entidades consultivas por el Consejo han expresado su interés en participar en la Conferencia y en sus actividades

preparatorias. Desde entonces, otras organizaciones no gubernamentales también pidieron ser acreditadas. El anexo al presente documento contiene la información necesaria para el Comité Preparatorio acerca de dichas organizaciones no gubernamentales. Cada una de ellas ha sido evaluada por la secretaría de la Conferencia, de conformidad con lo dispuesto en la resolución 1993/4 del Consejo, y se observó que respondía a los criterios fijados en dicha resolución. Por consiguiente, el Secretario General de la Conferencia recomienda al Comité Preparatorio la acreditación de las mencionadas organizaciones no gubernamentales.
