1995/... Improvement in the method of consideration of item 6
of the agenda of the Sub-Commission concerning
violations of human rights and fundamental freedoms

At its ... meeting, on ... August 1995, the Sub-Commission decided to consider at its forty-eighth session how best to carry out its mandate in examining item 6 of its agenda concerning violations of human rights and fundamental freedoms, while taking into account all reliable sources. In this regard, and taking into account the interest shown in the information contained in the reports of special rapporteurs and chairmen-rapporteurs of working groups of the Commission on Human Rights, the Sub-Commission requests the Secretariat, on the one hand, to make these reports available to the experts who request them at the forty-eighth session and, on the other hand, to undertake appropriate consultations with the special rapporteurs and chairmen-rapporteurs, in particular during their annual joint meeting, so that their preoccupations and those of the Sub-Commission can be taken into account. The Sub-Commission requests the Secretary-General to report on this meeting to the Sub-Commission at its forty-eighth session.
