LETTER DATED 29 APRIL 1994 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The members of the Security Council, while discussing the situation in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina and in the safe areas, established by the relevant resolutions of the Security Council, took note of the recommendations of the Secretary-General concerning the definition and implementation of the concept of safe areas, as contained in his reports of 10 March 1994 (S/1994/291) and 16 March 1994 (S/1994/300).

The members of the Council request the Secretary-General to submit by 10 May 1994 further specific recommendations on modalities of the implementation of the concept of safe areas as defined in resolutions 824 (1993) and 836 (1993).
