REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS  
OF THE REPRESENTATIVES AND DEPUTY AND ALTERNATE  
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL  
ELECTED FOR THE PERIOD 1994-1995

At its 43rd and 44th meetings, on 29 October 1993, the General Assembly elected Argentina, the Czech Republic, Nigeria, Oman and Rwanda as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years, beginning on 1 January 1994.

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that, with regard to the representation of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 1994-1995, he has received the communications referred to hereunder.

Argentina: Credentials from the Minister of External Relations, International Trade and Worship of Argentina signed on 18 November 1993 stating that Mr. Emilio Cardenas has been appointed representative of Argentina on the Security Council, Mr. Raúl Alberto Ricardes deputy representative and Mr. Carlos Sersale di Cerisano, Mr. Alejandro Nieto, Mr. Héctor Raúl Pelaez, Mrs. María Fernanda Cañas and Mr. Estanislao Angel Zawels alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

The Czech Republic: Credentials signed on 9 December 1993 by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic stating that Mr. Karel Kovanda has been appointed representative of the Czech Republic on the Security Council, Mr. Alexandr Slabý and Mr. Alexandr Sporýš deputy representatives and Mr. Karel Žebrakovský, Mr. Ivo Šrámek, Mr. Štefan Füle and Mr. Jiří Vaňhara alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Nigeria: Credentials from the Minister of External Affairs of Nigeria signed on 7 December 1993 stating that Mr. Ibrahim A. Gambari has been appointed representative of Nigeria on the Security Council, Mr. Isaac E. Ayewah and Mr. S. A. Otuyelu deputy representatives and Mr. Martin Uhomoibhi, Mr. P. A. Egunsola, Mr. A. B. Gwary and Miss R. O. Daio alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Oman: Credentials signed on 11 December 1993 by the Minister of State for Foreign Affairs of Oman stating that Mr. Salim bin Mohammed Al-Khussaiby has been appointed representative of Oman on the Security Council, Mr. Mohammed bin Abdullah bin Salim Al Sameen deputy representative and Mr. Salim bin Hamad Al Battashi, Mr. Said bin Ali Al-Amri, Mr. Mohammed bin Awadh Al-Hassan, Mr. Said bin Nasser Al-Harthy and Mr. Moosa bin Hamdan Al-Taei alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Rwanda: Credentials from the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of Rwanda signed on 17 December 1993 stating that Mr. Jean Damascène Bizimana has been appointed representative of Rwanda on the Security Council and Mr. Chaste Abimana deputy representative.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
