### FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION IN HAITI

#### Draft decision submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations

#### The General Assembly,

(a) Decides, as an ad hoc arrangement, and taking into account the amount of 21,202,240 dollars gross (20,840,040 dollars net) already assessed in accordance with General Assembly resolution 49/239 of 31 March 1995, to assess the additional amount of 42,404,480 dollars gross (41,680,080 dollars net) for the period from 1 August to 31 October 1995 among Member States in accordance with the composition of groups set out in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Assembly resolution 43/232 of 1 March 1989, as adjusted by the Assembly in its resolutions 44/192 B of 21 December 1989, 45/269 of 27 August 1991, 46/198 A of 20 December 1991, 47/218 A of 23 December 1992, 49/249 A of 20 July 1995 and 49/249 B of 14 September 1995 and its decision 48/472 A of 23 December 1993, and taking into account the scale of assessments for the year 1995; 1/

(b) Decides also that, in accordance with the provisions of its resolution 973 (X) of 15 December 1955, there shall be set off against the assessment among Member States, as provided for in paragraph (a) above, their respective share in the Tax Equalization Fund of the additional estimated staff assessment income of 724,400 dollars authorized for the Mission for the period from 1 August to 31 October 1995;

(c) Decides further to authorize the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the operation of the Mission for the period from 1 to 30 November 1995 in the amount of 21,202,240 dollars gross (20,840,040 dollars net);

(d) Decides, as an ad hoc arrangement, to assess the amount of 21,202,240 dollars gross (20,840,040 dollars net), for the period from 1 to 30 November 1995, among Member States in accordance with the scheme set out in paragraph (a) above;

(e) Decides also that, in accordance with the provisions of its resolution 973 (X), there shall be set off against the assessment among Member States, as provided for in paragraph (d) above, their respective share in the Tax Equalization Fund of the estimated staff assessment income of 362,200 dollars authorized for the Mission for the period from 1 to 30 November 1995.
