Report of the Fifth Committee

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1995, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fiftieth session the item entitled "Review of the efficiency of the administrative and financial functioning of the United Nations" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 45th meeting, on 22 December 1995. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/50/SR.45).
3. At the 32nd meeting of the Committee, on 28 November, the Chairman of the Joint Inspection Unit presented the annual report 1/ of the Unit.
