SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH
THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN
THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1996/15 of 11 January 1996, S/1996/15/Add.4 of 9 February 1996 and S/1996/15/Add.8 of 8 March 1996.

During the week ending 16 March 1996, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation in Somalia (see S/23370/Add.11, S/23370/Add.16, S/23370/Add.30, S/23370/Add.34, S/23370/Add.48, S/25070/Add.12, S/25070/Add.23, S/25070/Add.38, S/25070/Add.43, S/25070/Add.46, S/1994/20/Add.4, S/1994/20/Add.21, S/1994/20/Add.33, S/1994/20/Add.38, S/1994/20/Add.43, S/1995/40/Add.13 and S/1996/15/Add.3; see also S/23370/Add.3)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3641st meeting, held on 15 March 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations. There was one suspension and one resumption of the meeting.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Djibouti, Ethiopia, Guinea, India, Jordan, Kenya, Morocco, Pakistan, Rwanda, Swaziland, Tunisia, Uganda and Zimbabwe, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In response to the request contained in a letter dated 15 March 1996 from the Permanent Representative of Guinea-Bissau to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1996/196), the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Ibrahima Sy, Permanent Observer of the Organization of African Unity to the United Nations.
