Statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Yemen
on 15 March 1979

The Yemen Arab Republic is fully committed to the unanimous Arab position as stated in the resolutions adopted by the Arab Summit Conferences in Algeria, Rabbat and Baghdad. The Government believes that any separate solution is harming the cause of a just peace in the Middle East.

The Yemen Arab Republic confirms its long-standing position that the Palestine Liberation Organization is the sole legitimate representative of the Palestinian people.
