2. Pages 27 and 28 (PORTUGAL), article 3

(a) At the end of paragraph 1, underline the words "in accordance with the principles of international law";

(b) At the end of paragraph 2, underline the words "Such agreement shall, when the need arises, take into consideration an environmental impact assessment";

(c) At the end of paragraph 3, underline the words "in accordance with the principles of international environment law aiming at an enhanced protection of the watercourse and its ecosystems".

At the end of the paragraph, underline the words "conditioned by the protection of the watercourse in respect to the principle of sustainable development".

Underline the words "and enter into negotiations".

6. Page 59 (PORTUGAL), article 20

Underline the word "and" after the word "individually".
