SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/12520 of 9 January 1978 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 18 February 1978, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Complaint by Chad

In a letter dated 8 February 1978 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/12553), the representative of Chad requested that a meeting of the Security Council be convened, as a matter of urgency, to consider the serious situation prevailing in northern Chad as a result of Libyan aggression and of the Chad-Libyan frontier problem.

At its 2060th meeting, on 17 February 1978, the Security Council included the item in its agenda. The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Chad and the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
