INFORMATION CIRCULAR

Subject: POST ADJUSTMENT MULTIPLIER FOR NEW YORK*

1. In information circular ST/IC/1997/2 of 7 January 1997, staff members were informed that, upon implementation of the revised base salary scale effective 1 January 1997, revised post adjustment indices and multipliers would be established by the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) for all duty stations. Changes in post adjustment multipliers due after 1 January 1997 will be effected on the basis of the movement of the newly consolidated post adjustment indices.
2. In accordance with the above-mentioned procedure, ICSC has determined that post adjustment multiplier 44.4 should apply for staff in the Professional category and above serving in New York with effect from 1 January 1997. Consequently, effective 1 January 1997, the post adjustment multiplier for New York is being revised from 52 to 44.4.
3. The annual amounts of post adjustment at multiplier 44.4 for each salary level and step are shown in the annex to the present circular.
4. The implementation of the revised post adjustment multiplier will be reflected in the end of January 1997 payroll.
