LETTER DATED 29 APRIL 1997 FROM THE CHARGÉ D'AFFAIRES A.I.

Appendix

According to information received from officials of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran, United States warships and aircraft positioned in the Persian Gulf and the Sea of Oman created a nuisance for Iranian ships on the following dates and times:

(a) On 19 December 1996 at 1339 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2827 and E5006 locked radar over the Iranian battleship Khadang at the position of N2836 and E4955;

(b) On 19 December 1996 at 1350 hours, at the direction of 60 degrees north and a distance of seven miles from the Frouzan oil platform, a United States warship locked radar over the Iranian battleship Khadang.

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran protests these illegal activities by the Government of the United States and calls for an end to such actions.
