Summary of a letter dated 21 July 1997 to the Acting Chairman  
of the National Assembly of the Kingdom of Cambodia

In conformity with items 7, 10, 19 and 58 of the Internal Regulations of the National Assembly, we, the undersigned Members of Parliament request that any meeting of the National Assembly be postponed until such time as the situation in Cambodia returns to normal because, in the present climate of intimidation, Members of Parliament cannot carry out their duties in a spirit of independence and according to their consciences.

Note:

Item 7. The (12-member) Standing Committee of the National Assembly and the Assembly itself have the same (5-year) term. Therefore the 5 FUNCINPEC and BLDP members of the Standing Committee cannot be replaced before May 1998.

Item 10. The quorum required for the Standing Committee to meet is 7 out of 12 members. Since Son Soubert and Kem Sohka, Ahmed Yahya, Om Rasedy and Kan Man have fled the country following the coup and since Chairman Chea Sim serves as Acting Head of State, only 6 members of the Standing Committee can meet.

Item 19. Only the Standing Committee can convene the National Assembly and set the agenda of its meetings.

Item 58. A group of 10 Members of Parliament can request the postponement of any meeting of the National Assembly.
