SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1997/40 of 10 January 1997, S/1997/40/Add.10 of 21 March 1997, S/1997/40/Add.20 of 30 May 1997 and S/1997/40/Add.21 of 6 June 1997.

During the week ending 14 June 1997, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3787th meeting, held on 12 June 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at her request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1997/445) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1997/445, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1112 (1997) (for the text, see S/RES/1112 (1997); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

The situation in Tajikistan and along the Tajik-Afghan border (see S/25070/Add.34; S/1994/20/Add.37, 44 and 49; S/1995/40/Add.14, 19, 23, 33, 44 and 49; and S/1996/15/Add.20, 23, 37 and 49; and S/1997/40/Add.5 and 10; see also S/23370/Add.43)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3788th meeting, held on 12 June 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the situation in Tajikistan (S/1997/415).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Tajikistan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1997/444) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1997/444, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1113 (1997) (for the text, see S/RES/1113 (1997); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

The situation between Iraq and Kuwait (see S/21100/Add.30-33, 36-38, 42, 43 and 47; S/22110/Add.6-9, 13, 14, 17, 20, 24, 25, 32, 37 and 40; S/23370/Add.8, 11, 28, 34 and 39; S/25070/Add.1, 2, 5, 21, 24 and Corr.1, 26 and 47; S/1994/20/Add.8, 39-41 and 45; S/1995/40/Add.14; S/1996/15/Add.11, 12, 23 and 33; and S/1997/40/Add.15 and 22; see also S/23370/Add.10, 32, 35 and 47)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3789th meeting, held on 13 June 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1997/33; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).
