SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1997/40 of 10 January 1997, S/1997/40/Add.10 of 21 March 1997, S/1997/40/Add.20 of 30 May 1997, S/1997/40/Add.21 of 6 June 1997, S/1997/40/Add.28 of 25 July 1997, S/1997/40/Add.29 of 1 August 1997, S/1997/40/Add.31 of 15 August 1997, S/1997/40/Add.32 of 22 August 1997 and S/1997/40/Add.38 of 3 October 1997.

During the week ending 4 October 1997, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation in Angola (see S/25070/Add.4, 10, 17, 22, 23, 28, 37, 44 and 50; S/1994/20/Add.5, 10, 21, 25, 31, 35, 38, 42, 43 and 48; S/1995/40/Add.5, 9, 14, 18, 31, 40 and 50; S/1996/15/Add.5, 16, 18, 27, 40 and 49; and S/1997/40/Add.4, 8, 11, 12, 15, 26, 29 and 34; see also S/19420/Add.51; S/22110/Add.21; and S/23370/Add.12, 27, 37, 40, 43, 48 and 51)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3820th meeting, held on 29 September 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Angola, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1997/750) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations, and made a revision to the text of the draft resolution in its provisional form.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1997/750, as orally revised in its provisional form, and adopted it unanimously as resolution

1130 (1997) (for the text, see S/RES/1130 (1997); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).

The situation concerning Western Sahara (see S/11593/Add.42 and 44; S/19420/Add.38; S/21100/Add.25; S/22110/Add.17; S/23370; S/25070/Add.9; S/1994/20/Add.12, 29 and 45; S/1995/40/Add.1, 14, 20, 25, 37 and 50; S/1996/15/Add.21 and 47; and S/1997/40/Add.11 and 20)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3821st meeting, held on 29 September 1997 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the situation concerning Western Sahara (S/1997/742 and Add.1).

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1997/751) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1997/751, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1131 (1997) (for the text, see S/RES/1131 (1997); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-second Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1997).
