UNITED NATIONS PENSION SYSTEM

Benin, Chad, Egypt, Ghana, Kenya, Libyan Arab
Jamahiriya, Mauritania, Morocco, Senegal,
Zaire: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 33/121 B of 19 December 1978, 34/222 B of 20 December 1979 and 35/216 C of 17 December 1980,

Taking into consideration the report of the Joint Staff Pension Board, which recognizes that, in spite of some constraints due to the behaviour of the market, the four requirements have been complied with,

Concerned at the very low level of the investments made to date in the African States members of the Organization of African Unity,

1. Requests the Secretary-General to continue his consultations with each State member of the Organization of African Unity, the African Development Bank and other financial institutions in that continent with a view to improving the level of investments in member States;

2. Further requests the Secretary-General to report on this question to the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session.
