A. Letter dated 2 March 1998 from the Acting President of the General Assembly addressed to the Chairman of the Fifth Committee

As you are aware, on 19 December 1997, the General Assembly adopted resolution 52/12 B, entitled "Renewing the United Nations: a programme for reform". In paragraph 23 of that resolution, the Assembly noted that the Secretary-General had submitted the draft Code of Conduct for United Nations Staff to the Assembly, and agreed to expedite its consideration. The proposed United Nations Code of Conduct is contained in a report of the Secretary-General to the Assembly at its fifty-second session, under agenda item 114 (A/52/488).

I would greatly appreciate it if the Fifth Committee would consider the above-mentioned report as soon as possible.
