- Paragraph 1, line 1, replace the words "the present Statute" with "this Statute".
- Paragraph 1, line 3; replace the words "population and" with "population,"
- Insert the following at the end of paragraph 1,
"[(j bis). act of terrorism]"
- Insert the following at the end of paragraph 2, : (f) "Act of terrorism" means:
 - (i) An act of terrorism, in all its forms and manifestations involving the use of indiscriminate violence, committed against innocent persons or property intended or calculated to provoke a state of terror, fear and insecurity in the minds of the general public or populations resulting in death or serious bodily injury, or injury to mental or

physical health and serious damage to property irrespective of any considerations and purposes of a political, ideological, philosophical, racial, ethnic, religious or of such other nature that may be invoked to justify it, is a crime.

- (ii) This crime shall also include any serious crime which is the subject matter of a multilateral convention for the elimination of international terrorism which obliges the parties thereto either to extradite or to prosecute an offender.
