REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE SITUATION
IN ABKHAZIA, GEORGIA

Addendum

1. In my report of 29 October 1998 to the Security Council, I indicated in paragraph 46 that the financial implications for the increase in the number of internationally recruited security personnel to provide for the internal security of installations of the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia would be provided in an addendum to that document.

2. It is estimated that the costs associated with the increase of 17 international security personnel, together with 37 locally recruited security personnel and related logistical requirements, for a period of six months would be approximately \$1.5 million.

3. Should the Security Council concur in the recommendation contained in paragraph 46 of my report, I would then seek the additional resources required from the General Assembly. A breakdown of the estimated financial requirements is provided by main category of expenditure, for information purposes, in the annex to the present addendum.
