## **Employment of retirees**

### **Report of the Secretary-General**

#### **Addendum**

1. The present addendum provides, pursuant to paragraph 6 of document A/53/526, comparable data for the year 1995 on the employment of retirees in the United Nations Secretariat. The format of the statistical tables for 1995 is identical to that of the tables contained in the annex to document A/53/526.

2. The statistical data in the annex show that 351 separate engagements and reappointments for 227 retirees took place during the year 1995. Of this total, 54 per cent of engagements were for retirees in the Professional and higher categories and 10 per cent for retirees in the Field Service and General Service categories. Thirty-five per cent of engagements of retirees were by the modality of a special service agreement, covering both consultants and individual contractors. Fifty-three per cent of engagements were on a short-term basis. Table 1 shows the use of retirees by the type of engagement and table 2 shows a breakdown by category for 1995.

3. As indicated in table 3 in the annex to the present report, within the breakdown of the use of retirees by department or office, language services in the Office of Conference and Support Services in the Department of Administration and Management accounted for 117 engagements in 1995 (50 per cent of the total) and \$3.1 million. Looking at the use of retirees by nationality and gender (table 4), 53 engagements were by nationals of the United States of America (23 per cent), 32 by nationals of France (14 per cent), 19 by nationals of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (8 per cent) and 18 by nationals of Chile (8 per cent). Nationals of 46 countries were engaged as retirees, but ten countries accounted for 75 per cent of all engagements. Thirty-nine per cent of retirees engaged in 1995 were female.

4. Three main groups of functions carried out by retirees can be distinguished (table 5). Fifty-five per cent of engagements were for language services, in particular for revisers. Twenty-one per cent of engagements were for administrative functions and 22 per cent for



political, economic, social, environmental, humanitarian, advisory and technical assistance functions.

5. The largest percentage of retirees engaged in 1995 was in the 60 to 65 year age group (54 per cent), as set out in table 6. A further 27 per cent were in the 65 to 70 year age group.

6. The total cost of fees and salaries for the use of retirees in 1995 was \$4.5 million, of which language services accounted for \$3.1 million, or 69 per cent. Table 7 provides detailed information on the use of retirees in 1995 by department or office and by engagement.

**Explanatory notes:**

1. All data on the number of days of service in the tables have been rounded to the nearest 10 days. All data on fees and salaries have been rounded to the nearest thousand United States dollars, except in the detailed report (table 7), which presents exact amounts.
2. The baseline used in the report is 227 individual retirees employed in 1995, for a total of 351 engagements and a total of 21,070 days of service, at a cost of US\$ 4.475 million.
3. The database records individual engagements in each year of the reporting period. Differences in the number of persons engaged that appear in the totals of the tables are the result of the variable count of the engagements against different parameters. For instance, the number of 238 persons engaged in table 5 is higher than the baseline of 227 because 11 retirees have been engaged for more than one activity over the biennium. Similarly, the number of engagements by department may exceed the baseline because some retirees have been employed in more than one department during the reporting period. Only the count by nationality in table 4 corresponds to the baseline, since none of the retirees engaged in 1995 changed nationality during that year.
