LETTER DATED 20 NOVEMBER 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE

According to information received from the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran, on 23 June 1998, at 1030 hours, a United States F-14 aircraft, which was flying near and around the United States warship John C. Steines (CNN 74), at the position of N 2835 and E 5015, intercepted an Iranian P3F aircraft and, in a vertical air intercept manoeuvre, soared sharply upward in the path of the oncoming Iranian aeroplane.

Considering the fact that the dangerous activities of the United States aircraft are contrary to flight regulations, the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran strongly protests such illegal actions by the Government of the United States of America and calls for an end to these actions.
