Report of the Third Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 15 September 1998, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-third session the item entitled “Report of the Economic and Social Council”.
2. At the same meeting, the General Assembly decided to allocate to the Third Committee chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council¹ that were to be considered under the relevant items of the agenda (see A/C.3/53/1).
3. The Third Committee considered the item at its 53rd meeting, on 23 November 1998. An account of the Committee’s discussion is contained in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.3/53/SR.53).
4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the report of the Economic and Social Council for the year 1998.¹

II. Consideration of proposals

A. Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1999–2000

5. At the 53rd meeting, on 23 November, the representative of the Department of General Assembly Affairs and Conference Services introduced and orally revised the note by the

Secretariat (A/C.3/53/L.64) entitled "Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1999–2000" (see A/C.3/53/SR.53).

6. At the same meeting, the Committee approved its organization of work and draft biennial programme of work for 1999–2000, as orally revised (see para. 8, draft decision I).

B. Report of the Economic and Social Council

7. At its 53rd meeting, on 23 November, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it take note of the relevant chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council (see para. 8, draft decision II).

III. Recommendations of the Third Committee

8. The Third Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decisions:

Draft decision I

Organization of work of the Third Committee and biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1999–2000

The General Assembly, pursuant to its resolutions 45/175 of 18 December 1990, 46/140 of 17 December 1991 and 50/227 of 24 May 1996, approves the organization of work of the Third Committee and the biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1999–2000, as contained in annexes I and II to the present decision.

Annex I

Organization of work of the Third Committee

A. Guidelines concerning time limits of statements

1. In accordance with rule 106 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly and paragraph 22 of decision 34/401 on the rationalization of the procedures and organization of the General Assembly, at the beginning of each session, the Chairman of the Third Committee should propose to the Committee the limitation of the time to be allowed to speakers.

2. Further to General Assembly resolutions 45/175 of 18 December 1990 and 46/140 of 17 December 1991, on the rationalization of the work of the Third Committee, statements made by delegations and by Secretariat officials, unless decided otherwise by the Committee at the beginning of the session, should not exceed seven minutes. Statements made on behalf of a group of delegations or made in connection with the sub-items under the agenda item on human rights questions should not exceed fifteen minutes. These time limits will be applied with a degree of flexibility towards all speakers. With a view to saving time, all speakers are encouraged to exercise self-discipline, in particular delegations associated with group statements. For practical reasons, group statements are encouraged for the first day of the discussion of an item or sub-item. In this connection, it is important to emphasize the timely

distribution of documentation in accordance with the rules of procedure of the Assembly, in order to enable delegations to inscribe themselves on the list of speakers at an early stage.

B. Draft resolutions on reports of treaty bodies and reports of the Secretary-General on the status of the treaties

3. Reports of all treaty bodies will be submitted to the General Assembly in accordance with their respective legislative mandates. Substantive resolutions on those reports should be adopted biennially, in accordance with the programme of work of the Third Committee. Where possible, it is recommended that draft resolutions on the status of the treaties should not be submitted separately but should be incorporated in the draft resolution relating to the report of the treaty body. In alternate years, the Committee should simply take note of the reports unless more substantive action is deemed appropriate.

C. Proposals emanating from subsidiary organs of the Economic and Social Council

4. The Economic and Social Council, in transmitting proposals to the General Assembly should, to the extent possible, bear in mind the programme of work of the Third Committee.

D. Programme of work

5. An informal meeting of the Third Committee should be held immediately after the election of the members of its Bureau in order to consider the programme of work of the Committee based on a draft to be prepared by the Secretariat and to consider other organizational aspects relating to the Committee's work, especially the status of documentation.

6. The items allocated to the Third Committee for consideration during the fifty-fourth session of the General Assembly should be taken up in the following order:

- Item 2. Social development, including questions relating to the world social situation and to youth, ageing, disabled persons and the family;
- Item 3. Crime prevention and criminal justice;
- Item 4. International drug control;
- Item 5. Advancement of women;
- Item 6. Implementation of the outcome of the Fourth World Conference on Women;
- Item 7. Report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, questions relating to refugees, returnees and displaced persons and humanitarian questions;
- Item 8. Promotion and protection of the rights of children;
- Item 9. Programme of activities of the International Decade of the World's Indigenous People;
- Item 10. Elimination of racism and racial discrimination;^a
- Item 11. Right of peoples to self-determination;^a

Item 12. Human rights questions:^{b c}

- (a) Implementation of human rights instruments;
- (b) Human rights questions, including alternative approaches for improving the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms;
- (c) Human rights situations and reports of special rapporteurs and representatives;
- (d) Comprehensive implementation of and follow-up to the Vienna Declaration and Programme of Action;
- (e) Report of the United Nations Commissioner for Human Rights;

Item 1. Report of the Economic and Social Council.

7. This arrangement may be reviewed at the organizational meeting of the Third Committee, in particular, in the light of the status of documentation at that time.

E. Preparation and submission of draft resolutions

8. In drawing up draft resolutions, delegations are requested to adhere to the programme of work of the Third Committee as reproduced below.

9. Delegations are invited to take into account the general guidelines agreed upon in Assembly resolutions 45/175 and 46/140 regarding the submission of draft proposals and as set out below.^d
