Addendum

Note by the Secretariat

1. At its fifty-fourth session, the Commission on Human Rights, in its resolution 1998/51, entitled "Integrating the human rights of women throughout the United Nations system" called for further strengthening of cooperation and coordination between the Commission on Human Rights and the Commission on the Status of Women and between the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights and the Division for the Advancement of Women by, inter alia, preparing a joint work plan. The Commission also requested that the work plan continue to reflect all aspects of work under way and identify where obstacles/impediments exist and areas for further collaboration, and that it be made available to the Commission on Human Rights at its fifty-fifth session and to the Commission on the Status of Women at its forty-third session.

2. Pursuant to that request, the attention of the Commission on Human Rights is drawn to the report of the Secretary-General on the joint work plan prepared by the Division for the Advancement of Women and the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (E/CN.6/1999/2).
