Subject: **Official holidays for 2000 at United Nations Headquarters in New York**

1. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 52/214 A of 22 December 1997 and decision 52/468 of 31 March 1998, the 10 official holidays for 2000 at Headquarters in New York, following consultation with the staff representatives, have been designated as follows:

3 January	New Year's Day observance
7 January	Eid Al-Fitr observance
16 March	Eid Al-Adha
21 April	Good Friday
29 May	Memorial Day
4 July	Independence Day
4 September	Labour Day
23 November	Thanksgiving Day
25 December	Christmas Day
27 December	Eid Al-Fitr

2. Owing to the rare occurrence of Eid Al-Fitr twice in 2000 as a result of the lunar cycle, there will be no official holiday on Presidents' Day for next year only. Supervisors should approve requests for annual leave on that day, unless prevented by official exigencies.
