Note by the Secretary-General

1. In addition to the candidatures contained in documents E/CN.4/1299 and E/CN.4/1299/Add.1-3 the Secretary-General has received nominations of candidates from the Governments of Barbados, Ghana, Kenya, India, Iraq, Philippines and Tunisia for inclusion in the updated list of experts in economic, sociological, legal and other relevant disciplines, whose advice would be available to States concerned with the liquidation of slavery and the slave trade in all their practices and manifestations, including the slavery-like practices of apartheid and colonialism.
