Report of the Council Committee on Non-Governmental
Organizations

The Council Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations, acting in accordance with Council resolution 288.B.(X) met at United Nations Headquarters on 16 May 1955 under the chairmanship of Mr. Victor M. Rivas (Venezuela), to hear the applications of organizations in category A consultative status to be heard by the Council or its Committees under rule 86.
