WORKING GROUP I

7th meeting

Matters relating to commitments: criteria for joint implementation [2(e)]

The Working Group began its consideration of the sub-item and heard an introductory statement by the representative of the INC/FCCC Secretariat.

Statements were made by the representatives of Nauru, Norway, Greece (on behalf of the European Union), the Federated States of Micronesia, Finland, Russian Federation, Switzerland, Austria and Mexico.

The representative of Climate Action Network Latin America, a non-governmental organization, made a statement.

8th meeting

Matters relating to commitments: criteria for joint implementation [2(e)]

Statements were made by the representatives of Algeria (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China), Denmark, the Czech Republic, Australia, Sweden, Argentina, Poland, Saudi Arabia, Canada, Germany, Brazil, the Netherlands, China, Iceland, Peru, France, the United States of America, Thailand, New Zealand, Japan, Malaysia and Kenya.

France made a statement on a point of order.
