PETITION FROM CHIEF ABDULLAHI HAGI AHMED CONCERNING
SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

(Petition from Chief Sheik Abdullahi Hadji Ahmed)

Bardera, 29 September 1954

The undersigned chief with certain Notables and a number of other people who had come from the other side of the river to greet the Trusteeship Council were forbidden by the local Resident, Surdo Natalino, to see the Trusteeship Council. He instructed fifty policemen and twenty-five Ilalos to send all the people away, including the Santone, men and women, without seeing the Trusteeship Council. This was done on the orders of Dr. Troise, Provincial Commissioner for Upper Jubaland.

Please inform the United Nations how sorry we are not to have been allowed to see the United Nations Advisory Council at Mogadiscio. Thank you.
