PETITION FROM MR. FARAH GULED USSEN GIAMA CONCERNING
SOMALILAND UNDER ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION

of the Trusteeship Council)

TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADVISORY COUNCIL, Mogadiscio

The undersigned Farah Guled Ussen Giama, a former Chief Yuzbashi, aged 87, belonging to the Merehan tribe, living at the village of Scuraran, wishes to say that he is one of those old soldiers who had the honour to serve under Italian flag from 1913 to 1941.

For services rendered he was granted a monthly service pension of So.160 on which he was eking out his existence.

This morning he was informed by the head of the Ex-Servicemen's Office that from March of the present year he would not receive the pension.

As the undersigned is an old man incapable of doing any work because of his age and the serious illness from which he is suffering, he ventures to request you to be good enough to take up his case with the competent Italian authority so that he may be granted a service pension for life.
