PETITION FROM MR. KAMGOUE CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS
UNDER UNITED KINGDOM ADMINISTRATION
(T/PET.4 and 5/70)

Observations of the Government of the United
Kingdom as Administering Authority

There have been no mass arrests in the Cameroons under United Kingdom administration for the purpose of deportations to the former Trust Territory of the Cameroons under French administration or for any other purpose.

The reference to Mr. Kamden Louis in the petition appears to concern Mr. Gaston Kanga, also known as Mr. Gaston Louis Kamdoun or Louis Kamaoun. Mr. Gaston Kanga was declared a Prohibited Immigrant in the British Cameroons in November 1958; he was known to have entered the Southern Cameroons, and he was identified and arrested at Kumba in the Cameroons under United Kingdom administration in November 1959. He then gave his name as Louis Fornu. He did not exercise his right to be taken before a magistrate, and he was accordingly escorted to the frontier on 4 November.

The Governor-General possesses evidence that Mr. Gaston Kanga is an officer of an organization which is illegal in the Cameroons under United Kingdom administration.
