Observations of the French Government
as Administering Authority

The Administering Authority points out that it is the constant practice that taxpayers who go to work outside the Territory and return to their village after a short absence pay taxes in their village. Those who emigrate permanently and produce evidence that they are paying taxes in their new place of residence are struck off the register in their village of origin.

The persons mentioned in the petition have failed to produce such evidence, for which the Commandant de cercle of Tsévie has asked them again and again.
