Sir,

Further to my petition T/PET.3/90 and Add.1^{1/} and the replies of the Special Representative to Mr. ANTONOV's questions: I have the honour to inform you that some immovable property has just been sold, on 5 December 1959, and there are still two houses to be sold, namely the house at Kigali and the house at Astrida; I do not know the date on which they will be sold and I do not know why the administrator is dragging out the winding up of the estate, the time-limit expired a year ago.

As to the matter of the 180,000 francs (ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY THOUSAND FRANCS), this is not merely imagination on my part, since I am in possession of a judgement handed down by the Court of First Instance of Ruanda-Urundi at Usumbura on 6 November 1957, R.C.8333; it is quite right, I should have this amount.

Consequently, Sir, I ask you to be good enough to keep this matter under consideration so that I may obtain the division of the estate as soon as possible.
