Sir,

I would very respectfully inform you that for the fourth time I have been put in prison without proper cause. I was told to leave my plot of land without compensation. I refused and was taken to prison. I ask why you have allowed them to imprison me without cause for two months and fifteen days.

They want to kill me and my whole family, because I denounce them for what they are doing.

Are you sending me any letters? I ask this, because I have seen no letter from you other than letter T/PET/3/L.7.
