SUBJECT: PROTEST

To: The High Commissioner of the  
Republic in the Cameroons,  
YAOUNDE.

Sir,

We, the members of the Central Committee of the U.P.C. of Manjo, have the honour to write to you and to draw the High Commissioner's attention to the following matter:

We protest most emphatically against the facts contained in the extract from the Official Gazette (page 1661) of 8 December 1954.

Requisition No. 144 of 17 October 1954, issued under the terms of the Order of 23 March 1921, states that in accordance with the report drawn up on 10 February 1925, transcribed as No. 69 of 24 October 1925, an area of 4,000 hectares has been enclosed at Ngol, and placed at the disposal of the authorities.

All this land has been placed entirely at the disposal of the authorities.

We emphasize that we strongly oppose this act, and request the High Commissioner of the Republic in the Cameroons to declare null and void his decision appearing in the Official Gazette of 8 December 1954.
