ONE KAMERUN (O. K.)

MOTTO: UNITED WE STAND, DIVIDED WE FALL.

SLOGAN: "FORWARD TO FREEDOM, BACKWARD NEVER".

1. To fight relentlessly to achieve and maintain Independence for the chiefs and peoples of One Kamerun (Kamerun as from 1885 to 1916).
2. To serve as the vigorous conscious political Vanguard for removing all forms of oppressions and for the establishment of a democratic socialist nation.
3. To secure and maintain the complete unity of the peoples of the Eastern, Western and Northern territories as from 1885 to 1916 and to call on the United Nations to terminate the trusteeship agreement between Her and Franco-Britain.
4. To work with and in the interest of the trade union movements and other kindred organisations, in joint political or other action in harmony with the constitution and standing orders of the party and to press for the Kamerunization of the Kamerun civil service and the close down of redundant posts in the country.
5. To work for a speedy reconstruction of a better Kamerun in which the chiefs and peoples shall have to live and govern themselves as free peoples.
6. To promote the political, social, educational and economic emancipation of the peoples, more particularly of those who depend directly upon their own exertions by hand or by brain for the means of life.
7. To establish a socialist state in which all men and women shall have equal opportunity without sexual discrimination of any form and where there shall be no capital raping of the state (exploitation).
8. To work tirelessly to end up tribalism in the Kamerun and to be freely disposed to all races with no discrimination against anybody but unalterably opposed to imperialism, capitalism and colonialism in any form.
9. To join hands with other nationalist democratic and social movements in Africa and other continents, with a view to abolishing imperialism, colonialism, racialism, tribalism and all forms of national racial oppression and economic inequality among nations, races and peoples and to support all actions for world peace.

10. The membership shall be open to all none integrationists and persons previously affiliated to any such movements or organizations shall be required to make press and public denunciation of their previous organizations before they can apply for membership into the O.K. All persons attached to anti-colonial movements in or outside the Kamerun and who are none integrationists, shall be legible for membership. All members of the O.K. shall be neutral of Nigerian politics.

All the above aims are subject to amendments and modification by the convention.
