We would be obliged if you would pass this letter on to the United Nations Trusteeship Council as an expression of part of the Trade Union Movement of Australia, against the exploitation of the land rights of the people of Bougainville, New Guinea.

"This Executive expresses vigorous opposition to the action of the Administration of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea in violating the land rights of the native people of Bougainville, by resuming their land to provide facilities to a private Company to exploit copper deposits and demands that the Federal Government takes action to ensure that the traditional land rights of these people are protected against private commercial exploitation."
