I have the honour to inform you that, after being burgled on the night of 31 December 1954 by certain dissidents acting on colonialist instigation, the Central Office of the Mouvement de la Jeunesse Togolaise (JUVENTO) obliged the National Committee to discard the headed notepaper formerly in use, a specimen of which is attached, and to adopt henceforth that on which this letter is written.

Needless to say, therefore, all correspondence previously addressed to you on the disused headed notepaper and bearing the signature of Napo Badji, and all such correspondence which is sure to reach you in the future, should be regarded as null and void.
