NOTE RELATING TO THE ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA
FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S SIXTEENTH REGULAR SESSION

The following is for use in connection with Page 1 of the Annotated Provisional Agenda for the Sixteenth Regular Session (Press Release GA/2250) distributed today:

By 7 September, a total of 93 items had been proposed for inclusion in the agenda of the sixteenth session. They include 77 items on the provisional agenda, 15 on the supplementary list, and one "additional item." (The various terms are explained on Page 1 of the press release; background on the items appears in the subsequent pages of the release.)

The preceding session of the Assembly, held in two parts in the fall of 1960 and the spring of 1961, approved a total of 92 items for its agenda -- the largest number up to that time.
