After the words, "The Sub-Committee had discussed" insert the following: *l*  
"the matter informally with the International Union, but had pointed out  
that directives from the General Assembly made it clear that UNICEF was to  
seek contributions from voluntary sources. Consequently, the Sub-Committee  
had not felt it possible to accede to the International Union's desire.  
The Sub-Committee wished to make it clear, however, its feeling that many  
of the difficulties that were envisaged by the Union could to a great extent  
be overcome at the national level. There was no intention to impose any  
function on national committees, in relation to fund-raising for instance.  
That was a matter entirely for each committee's discretion. Moreover, there  
should be consultation with non-governmental organizations prior to the  
forming of any national committee."
