COMPOSITION OF THE SECRETARIAT

Niger, Upper Volta and Zaïre: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Having considered the composition of the Secretariat and the long-term recruitment plan,

Being concerned, in accordance with Article 8 of the Charter, to ensure that no restrictions are placed on the eligibility of men and women to participate in any capacity and under conditions of equality in the work of the Secretariat,

Being concerned also to avoid any discrimination between staff members on grounds of sex,

Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its twenty-eighth session a study on Secretariat practices that might be construed as promoting discrimination against women.
