REPORTS OF THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION:

RESOLUTION OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Canada: Amendment to Canadian Draft Resolution A/C1/308

This amendment is to replace the second part of paragraph 8 and the whole of paragraph 9 of Document A/C1/308 by the three following paragraphs numbered 9, 10 and 11:

9. CONFIRMS the Commission's analysis of the impasse it has encountered in the fulfilment of its task as set forth in the Third Report.

10. REGRETS that unanimous agreement has not yet been reached on the plan of control and prohibition approved in para. 8 above and RECOGNIZES the grave dangers to international peace and security resulting from the absence of such control.

11. REQUESTS the sponsors of the General Assembly Resolution of 24 January 1946, who are the permanent members of the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, to consult following this session, in order to determine when there exists a basis for agreement on the control of atomic energy; the sponsors thereupon to request the Secretary-General to reconvene the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, the activities of which have been suspended, in order to resume its task; and, in any event, the sponsors shall report the results of their consultation to the next regular session of the General Assembly.
