REPORT OF THE TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL

Plans of political reform for the Trust Territory of
Ruanda-Urundi

Ghana: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Having taken note of the statement of the Administering Authority (A/C.4/432) concerning the political reforms envisaged for the Trust Territory of Ruanda-Urundi under Belgian administration,

Having taken note of documents T/PET.3/95, T/PET.3/96 and T/PET.3/97 dealing with the recent outbreak of violence in the Territory,

Having further taken note of the statement of the Administering Authority on the incidents leading to the outbreak of violence which have resulted in the sending of troops to the Territory,

Having heard the views of the petitioner, Mr. John Kale,

1. Draws the attention of the Trusteeship Council to the statement of the petitioner on the Trust Territory of Ruanda-Urundi;

2. Requests the Trusteeship Council to consider in detail the plans of political reforms envisaged for the Territory by the Administering Authority and to include its observations and recommendations on the plans in its report to the General Assembly at its fifteenth session, taking into account the provisions of General Assembly resolutions(XIV) on the attainment of self-government or independence by Trust Territories.
