

## SIXTH COMMITTEE

## SUB-COMMITTEE 1 ON PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES

CO-ORDINATION OF THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF THE  
UNITED NATIONS AND OF THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES

Proposal by the Delegation of Canada

1. The Canadian delegation considers that the Resolution of the General Assembly, dated 13 February 1946, on the co-ordination of the privileges and immunities of the United Nations and of the specialized agencies (Resolution 6, D, page 33 of the Resolutions adopted in London) could be best implemented if the Assembly were to adopt two resolutions as follows:

- (a) A resolution recommending to Members of the United Nations and to other states members of specialized agencies that they accede to a General Convention on the privileges and immunities of specialized agencies (along the lines of that contained in document A/339);
- (b) A resolution recommending to the specialized agencies that they consider the desirability of modifying certain privileges and immunities which the specialized agencies, representatives of members or officials might otherwise enjoy.

2. The two resolutions could be framed in the following manner:

- (a) "RESOLUTION RELATING TO A GENERAL CONVENTION ON PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF SPECIALIZED AGENCIES

## THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

APPROVES the annexed Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the specialized agencies; and

RECOMMENDS to all its Members and to other states members of the specialized agencies that they accede to this Convention.

- (b) "RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE FURTHER CO-ORDINATION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES.

The General Assembly of the United Nations adopted on the 13 February 1946,

RECEIVED a resolution contemplating the unification as far as possible of the

/privileges and

privileges and immunities enjoyed by the United Nations and by the various specialized agencies;

To this end, the General Assembly adopted on \_\_\_\_\_ a further resolution approving a Convention on Privileges and Immunities of specialized agencies and recommending to all its Members and to other states members of specialized agencies that they accede to this Convention;

Further co-ordination of these Privileges and Immunities is possible and desirable. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, by virtue of the power vested in it by Articles 58 and 60 of the Charter, therefore

RECOMMENDS that consideration be given by the specialized agencies concerned to the desirability of modifying, to the extent indicated in the relevant annexes to this resolution, the privileges and immunities which would otherwise be enjoyed by such agencies, representatives of members and officials thereof.

REQUESTS these specialized agencies to report to the General Assembly at its third session what progress has been made in this direction.
