SCHEDULE OF WORK OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

Note by the Chairman

The eleventh session of the General Assembly allocated fifteen items to the Fifth Committee - fourteen items were included in A/C.5/671 and the additional item related to the administrative and financial arrangements for UNEF. During its meetings in 1956, the Committee concluded its action on seven items, and further made very substantial progress on two items and has partially dealt with two other items. Discussion of the remaining four items has still to begin.

I am submitting below for the consideration of the Committee, suggestions as to how the outstanding work programme of the Committee might be scheduled.
