Credentials of the representatives, deputy representatives and alternate representatives of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 2021–2022

Report of the Secretary-General

1. On 17 June 2020, the General Assembly held elections by secret ballot without a plenary meeting. The Assembly elected India, Ireland, Kenya, Mexico and Norway as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years beginning on 1 January 2021.

2. Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that, with regard to the representation of the members of the Council elected for the period 2021–2022, he has received the following communications:
