Letter dated 18 February 2021 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the United States Mission to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I write to notify the Security Council, on behalf of my Government, that the United States of America hereby withdraws its letters to the Security Council of 20 August 2020 ([S/2020/815](#)), 21 August 2020 ([S/2020/822](#)) and 21 September 2020 ([S/2020/927](#)). It is the view of the United States that the measures contained in paragraphs 7, 8 and 16 to 20 of resolution [2231 \(2015\)](#) remain in effect and that the provisions of resolutions [1696 \(2006\)](#), [1737 \(2006\)](#), [1747 \(2007\)](#), [1803 \(2008\)](#), [1835 \(2008\)](#) and [1929 \(2010\)](#) that were terminated by resolution [2231 \(2015\)](#) remain terminated.

I ask that you circulate the text of the present letter as a document of the Security Council.
