CORRIGENDUM TO WORKING PAPER ON AN INTERNATIONAL BILL OF RIGHTS
(ITEM 8 ON PROVISIONAL AGENDA)

(Memorandum by the Division of Human Rights)

The working paper on an International Bill of Rights (E/CN.4/W.4) was prepared before the publication, on 18 January 1947, of the official text of the peace treaty with Roumania.

Under the circumstances, the quotations on page 4 of the working paper should be amended as follows:

Article 4 - line 4 - should read:

"favour of, or because of their sympathies with,"

Article 4 - lines 6 - 9 - should read:

"thereunder, shall complete these measures and shall in future not take any measures or enact any laws which would be incompatible with the purposes set forth in this Article."

Article 5 - lines 5 - 6 - should read:

"Soviet Union or to any of the other United Nations, shall not permit in future the existence and activities of organizations"

Lines 7 and 8 from the bottom should read as follows:

"status, political or civil rights or any other matter."
(article 3 bis in the Roumanian treaty and article 2 bis in the Hungarian treaty.)
