Germany

In a communication dated 19 March 2021, the Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations informed the Secretariat of the following:

There are no scholarships offered exclusively to residents of the Non-Self-Governing Territories. However, between March 2020 and January 2021, Germany funded 386 scholarships for individuals from France, New Zealand, the United Kingdom and the United States, including the Territories administered by these States, amounting to about €3 million. Students from Non-Self-Governing Territories are eligible to apply for various scholarship programmes offered to all foreign nationals, including long- and short-term scholarships and the Graduate School Scholarship Programme.
